CLGA President Kathy Langston called the meeting to order at 12:15 p.m.

Approval of minutes: Kathy Langston asked to approve the January 2026 general meeting minutes posted on the CLGA website. Vote passed to approve the minutes.

Budget: Deb Bohac referenced the budget report at the tables for members to review. Deb explained that there would still be a few expenses coming through and that the final year end budget would be the end of month May budget report. Deb explained that in the final column that the numbers in red reflected where we were under budget and in black is our numbers where over or on budgeted amount. Deb explained that patio parties and luncheons were slightly over budget and that had been approved by the board to go over. Deb Walsh mentioned that the Community Partners financial support increased our final budget and that the membership survey would be asking our members where they would like to see additional funds spent. We did use some of this money this season to subsidize luncheons and patio parties.

AGA/Community Partnership Program: Nancy Mastalski presented Karen Fischer with a certificate from the AGA for her Hole-in-One on hole 8 (117 yards) made using a 6 hybrid on April 9th, 2026. Nancy shared that \$3400 was received to our league from local businesses who we asked to partner with us as part of the Community Partnership Program. Nancy has followed up with the businesses sharing the link to our community partners page on our CLGA website. Sponsors expressed appreciation for how we partnered with them and liked the website and Splash focus. A couple of businesses expressed interest already with partnering with us again next season.

Member Appreciation: Kathy Langston expressed appreciation to all members who made contributions to make the league a success this season. Kathy called forward and presented a gift of appreciation to Ruby Meyers, Barb Amedro, Nadine Sanders, and Trudy Houghton for stepping up and going above and beyond with the specific contributions they made this season.

Voting Results: Trudy Houghton shared that we had a great response for the voting for our 2026-2027 Board Members with 77 percent of our membership voting. Our new board members voted in for the 2026-2027 season will be: Deb Bohac – President, Tara Bradford – Vice President and Deb Walsh – Secretary. Sue Kish will continue in her second term as Treasurer.

Summer Play: Deb Bohac communicated that last year we invited the Cottonwood 9'ers League and Palo Verde 18 Hole Ladies League to join us for summer play. A full schedule of games for the entire summer is ready and will be sent out soon. We are looking to extend the summer play to all Sun Lakes ladies as well as to guests. Games will all be individual games since in the summer number of individuals playing is usually lower. Payouts will be in chits and we are looking at charging \$4 for the game and \$1 to get in to the birdie pot. Deb encouraged members to attend the board meeting following the luncheon if they have input they would like to provide on summer play.

Recognition to our President: Deb Bohac presented Kathy Langston with a bouquet of flowers and a gift card and recognized Kathy for some of her contributions to include: creating a cohesive and thoughtful board, organization of the league room and bulletin boards in the Pro Shop, Birdie Blast weekly communication, website updates, branding, community partners program, updated bylaws and standing rules, and expanding digital records that allow for ease with accessibility and transferability.
